Old Business

The proposal of taking over Oak Alley as a township road is still being handled by Allen at this time.

The newly revised Floodplain Ordinance is still under review with DCED

The tree on Canoe Mt. Drive was removed from Mrs. Bigelow's. The bill was actually less than what was expected and was \$150.00.

New Business

Present tonight was Dave McFarland from Blair County Planning Commission. He was here to show a presentation on the Blair County Planning Commission. It was an overview of who they are, their mission statement, where they have been in the past and what they are planning to accomplish in the future. He also explained some of the services that Blair County Planning Commission offers to the municipality.

Barrie is going to meet with meet with someone to draw up plans for a septic system and get ready to put it out to bid. Barrie is going to award the bid to the lowest bidder as authorized by the Chairman and Vice-Chairman.

Mr. David Imler had sent a request to Allen Gibboney of Gibboney and Gibboney to take action on a matter with taxes not being paid to the township from a company called Centax. As of this month's meeting Allen had not replied so Dave brought it before the board of supervisors. The supervisors are going to inquire to Allen as to how much pursuing legal action against Centax would cost and what it would entail. Barrie made a motion to do this, David seconded it and all were in favor.

Mr. Rick Baker has noticed some tractor and trailers on Canoe Mt. Drive. He has the road bonded for his Logging Company, Baker Logging and is worried that if damage is done to the road his company legally will have to pay for the damage even if it was caused by the

other truck drivers. The supervisors discussed and motioned to contact Keller Engineers and the State Police to see if they can be of any help in monitoring the situation.

Payment for the township office will happen in three installments to B&W construction and will come from the PLGIT General Account and from the Sewer Fund which will eventually be closed out and transferred to the Hi-Fi General account.

Mr. Theodore McDowell had requested to have his name put as contable on the township website. Kara will contact David Love to make this request.

A motion was made to pay the bills.
