CATHARINE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 69

AN ORDINANCE OF CATHARINE TOWNSHIP, BLAIR COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE 36 REGARDING ISSUANCE OF BUILDING PERMITS.

The Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, hereby enact and ordain as follows:

1.

Catharine Township Ordinance No. 36 is hereby amended as follows: Section 209 of Catharine Township Ordinance No. 36 is hereby stricken in its entirety.

2.

Section 209 of Catharine Township Ordinance No. 36 shall now hereafter be as follows:

Each application for a building permit shall be accompanied by a fee, payable to Catharine Township. Said fee shall be based upon the estimated cost of the proposed construction as determined by the Township of Catharine at the rate as herein after set forth, or, if the application is for a mobile home (a mobile home being defined as one having a motor vehicle title) at the mobile home rate:

A. Estimated Cost	Fee
\$0.00 to \$200.00 \$200.01 to \$1,000.00	\$ 0.00 \$25.00
Each additional \$1,000.00 or part thereof in excess of \$1,000.00	\$ 1.00
B. Mobile Home Rate	\$25.00

In all other respects, the Supervisors of Catharine Township do hereby ratify and confirm the provisions of Ordinance No. 36 as supplemented and amended.

4.

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

5.

The effective date of this Ordinance shall be five days after the enactment and ordaining thereof.

6.

If any section, portion or provision of this Ordinance is judicially held to be illegal, unconstitutional or unenforceable, such decision shall not affect the remainder hereof. It is hereby declared to be the intent of the Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township that this ordinance would have been adopted if any such illegal, unconstitutional or unenforceable provision had not been included herein.
