

Ordinance Number 19

An ordinance signifying the intention and desire of the Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, to create and establish a Township Planning Commission under the provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Act 247 of July 31, 1968 for the purpose of preparing and adopting of a plan of development for the Township of Catharine based on the physical, social, economic and governmental conditions and trends, and to encourage the coordinated development of the Township of Catharine and the general welfare and prosperity of its residents.

Be it ordained and enacted by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Catharine.

Section 1. That the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Catharine hereby signifies its intention and desire to organize a Township Planning Commission under the provisions of the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, Act 247 of July 31, 1968 as amended and supplemented.

Section 2. The Planning Commission shall consist of 5 members, all of whom shall be citizens of the Township of Catharine. The term of office of the members shall be four (4) years or until a successor is appointed, except that the terms of the members first appointed shall be so fixed that no more than two (2) shall be appointed during during any future calendar year. In the event of vacancies the governing body shall appoint a member to fill the unexpired term. Members whose terms have expired shall hold office until their successors have been appointed.

Section 3. The names, addresses, and terms of office of the members of the Planning Commission are as follows:

Section 4. That the Planning Commission shall prepare and adopt a plan for the development of the Township of Catharine, and which plan for the development shall be based on studies of the physical, social, economical, and governmental conditions and trends and shall be designed to promote with the greatest efficiency and economy the coordinated development of the Township of Catharine and the general welfare and prosperity of its residents.

Section 5. All other resolutions and ordinances or parts thereof, inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
