

AN ORDINANCE OPENING A STREET EXTENDING FROM LEGISLATIVE ROUTE 260 ALONG THE JUNIATA RIVER LANDS OF WILLIAMSBURG BOROUGH, WEST VIRGINIA PULP AND PAPER COMPANY, WILLIAMSBURG VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK, PLAYGROUND AREA, AND PARTS OF HOME STREET AND CHESTNUT STREET.

THE Board of Supervisors of Catherine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, ordain as follows:

The following streets or portions of streets are hereby opened, widened, and ordained as public roads or streets of Catherine Township, Blair County Pennsylvania.

SECTION 1. BEGINNING at a point on the Southeasterly side of Legislative Route #260 at line of land of Anthony F. Prysbeck; thence by line of land of said Prysbeck South 76 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds East 104.07 feet to a point; thence South 48 degrees 20 minutes 30 seconds East 104.57 feet to a point; thence by line of land of said Prysbeck, Robert Landis and West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company South 56 degrees 40 minutes East 207.36 feet to a point; thence continuing by line of land of West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company North 50 degrees 45 minutes East 392.84 feet to a point; thence by a curve to the left having a radius of 162.08 feet a distance of 173.08 feet to a point; thence North 10 degrees 26 minutes West along the westerly side of an alley 845 feet to a point the intersection of the westerly line of the street or road now being described with the Northerly side of Chestnut Street; thence North 79 degrees 34 minutes East 33 feet to a point; thence by a line through land of the playground area; Williamsburg Veterans Memorial Park and West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company the following two courses and distances; South 10 degrees 26 minutes East 845 feet to a point and by a curve to the right having a radius of 195.08 feet a distance of 208.32 feet to a point; thence by line of land of the Borough of Williamsburg South 50 degrees 45 minutes West and through land of Williamsburg Borough and the West Virginia Pulp and Paper Company South 50 degrees 45 minutes West 317.07 feet to a point; thence West 56 degrees 40 minutes West 234 feet to a point in the Juniata River; thence along said River North 48 degrees 20 minutes 30 seconds West 113.31 feet to a point; thence North 76 degrees 35 minutes 30 seconds West 116.71 feet to a point on the Westerly side of Legislative Route #260; thence along Legislative Route #260 North 24 degrees 13 minutes 30 seconds East 33.60 feet to the point the place of beginning, the said parcel of land to be used as a street or road with a width of 33 feet.

SECTION 2. That portion of Home Street bounded and described as follows: BEGINNING at a point the intersection of the Southerly line of Home Street with the Westerly side of the Street described in Section One hereof; thence along the Southerly side of Home Street South 79 degrees 34 minutes West 120 feet to a point on Legislative Route #260; thence along the Easterly line of Legislative Route #260 North 10 degrees 26 minutes West 50 feet to

a point; thence along the Northerly side of Home Street North 79 degrees 34 minutes East 120 feet to a point; thence along the Westerly side of the street described in Section One hereof South 10 degrees 26 minutes East 50 feet to the place of beginning.

SECTION 3. That portion of Chestnut Street, BEGINNING at a point the intersection of the Southerly line of Chestnut Street with the Westerly line of the street described in Section One hereof; thence along the Southerly side of Chestnut Street South 79 degrees 34 minutes West 120 feet to a point in the Easterly side of Legislative Route #260; thence along the Easterly line of Legislative Route #260 North 10 degrees 26 minutes West 50 feet to a point; thence along the Northerly side of Chestnut North 79 degrees 34 minutes East 153 feet to a point on the Westerly side of the street described in Section One hereof; thence along the Westerly side of the street described in Section One hereof South 10 degrees 26 minutes East 50 feet to the place of beginning.
