

ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE OF CATHARINE TOWNSHIP LIMITING THE WEIGHT OF VEHICLES ON TOWNSHIP ROADS NO. 458 AND 459.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED BY the Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township, County of Blair, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of same as follows:

SECTION 1. Vehicles having a weight, with load, in excess of Ten (10) Tons, is hereby prohibited from being operated upon Catharine Township Roads No. 458 and 459. Appropriate signs posting this weight limit shall be erected in and along the said routes.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating a provision of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before a District Justice, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars, and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment in the Blair County Jail for not less than five (5) days.
