Shall cause or permit earth or manure to be deposited thereon by any trucks, wagons, tractors or other machinery or cause or permit any trucks, wagons, tractors or other farm machinery to be driven from fields onto highways of Catharine Township, for the purpose of making a U-Turn.

III.

Any person violating this ordinance shall pay a fine of Twenty and no/100 (\$20.00) Dollars for each violation and default thereof, shall undergo imprisonment in the Blair County Jail for a term not to exceed Forty-Eight (48) hours.
