## ORDINANCE NO. 28A

AN ORDINANCE OF CATHARINE TOWNSHIP ORDAINING A ROAD COMMENCING ON THE WESTERLY SIDE OF PENNSYLVANIA U.S. ROUTE NO. 22 AND CONTINUING IN A WESTERLY DIRECTION A DISTANCE OF 2040 FEET TO LAND OF WILLIAM L. HUETHER, AS A PUBLIC ROAD OF CATHARINE TOWNSHIP

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township, County of Blair and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

WHEREAS, a petition has been presented to the Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township for the ordaining as a public road, a road hereinafter described, said petition having been signed by all the abutting owners and releasing any damages resulting from the ordaining and opening of the said road hereinafter described, as a public road of Catharine Township; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held, after due advertisement, at the regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township on the first Monday of May, 1977; and

whereas, it appearing to the Board of Supervisors that said road should be ordained a public road of Catharine Township for the convenience of the parties whose lands abut thereon and for the use of the general public;

NOW THEREFORE, the following road, having a width of thirtythree (33) feet is hereby ordained a public road of Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, to wit:

BEGINNING at a point on the Westerly side of Pennsylvania U.S. Route No. 22, said point being opposite the junction of T.R.458 with the said Pennsylvania U.S. Route No. 22 and extending thence in a Westerly direction at a uniform width of 33 feet a distance of 2040 feet to lands of William L. Huether and Helen D. Huether, his wife, upon which a turn-around will be constructed, said road being bounded on the South by lands of Ralph S. and Josephine R. Rispoli, Edward and Victoria Zukowski, and William L. and Helen D. Huether and on the North by lands of Gertrude Mingle Estate, Edward and Victoria Zukowski and William L. and Helen D. Huether.
