## MINUTES FOR THE FEBRUARY 16, 2023 MEETING OF THE CATHARINE TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

River Front Drive- a 16' cartway is needed before Penn Dot will allow the township to take over the road. The township will acquire more information before moving on with this.

No action will be taken on a Solar Ordinance. According to our solicitor, this would be hard to enforce and regulate.

A Dog Ordinance will be advertised before the next meeting for approval.

Jamie Smith Minor Lot Re-Subdivision was presented and approved. Heather Flaig made a motion to approve the Re-Subdivision, seconded by Ralph Rispoli.

Oak Alley- There have been several complaints about activity happening on and around Oak Alley. 15 residents signed a letter asking the supervisors to take action. Complaints include over weight trucks using the alley, pieces of equipment using the alley, noise nuisances late at night, a lot of junk and vehicles surrounding the alley, trucks blocking the alley, excess water drainage coming from the back side of the alley. The township's solicitor will look into a few things and further information will be obtained.

## **Roadmaster Report**

An estimate for a 4x8 sign from US Municipal was \$450-\$500 for a sign on the side of the building facing Yellow Springs. Other estimates will be looked into. A flag pole with a light was suggested for out front. Prices will be gotten. Road Master is working on Road Inspections. Etna Furnace is still in need of paving. Cross Valley is needing some repair and maintenance. Road Master is still looking for another truck for sale. Road salt should last until next winter.
