

MINUTES FOR APRIL 5, 2010 MEETING OF THE CATHARINE TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS

Mr. Rispoli called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. All members were present.
Visitors were Robert Mingle and Deborah Haldeman

David made a motion to accept the March 2010 minutes as written. Barrie seconded them and all were in favor.

Barrie made a motion to accept the March 2010 financial report as written. David seconded them and all were in favor.

Old Business

The proposal of taking over Oak Alley as a township road is still being handled by Allen at this time.

Mrs. Haldeman was here to readdress the campsite situation and to ask questions about whether there were township guidelines to prohibit campers and campsites. The supervisors assured her that the proper permits were being acquired as to the properties in question. As long as the property owners are in compliance with the current ordinances the supervisors have no other jurisdiction with the matter.

New Business

Mr. Mingle was here to ask to request that the Edgewood Drive sign be replaced. It has disappeared since one of the snow storms. The secretary will order a new sign and the road workers will put it back up as soon as it is received. Mr. Mingle also stated that a number of years ago there was a sign that read Ganister Village in the community of Ganister. The residents would like to see the Village of Ganister sign put back up as it offered a nice distinction for the area. The secretary will write to PennDot requesting the sign on behalf of the residents.

Allen has researched and drafted a new Floodplain Ordinance. The ordinance was sent to DCED and it is currently under their review. They will notify the township with any changes or comments of the review before it will be advertised for adoption by Catharine Township.

The building plans for the township office were reviewed and approved by CCIS. The secretary will advertise an invitation for bids that will be opened at the May 2010 monthly meeting.

David brought to light an issue with the tree on the shortcut. He is going to inquire as to how much it would cost to get the tree removed .

The Spring PSATS Convention is scheduled for April 29, 2010 at the Williamsburg Farm Show building.

Meeting was adjourned at 6:58 pm.
