

An Ordinance to vacate and abandon a portion of a road wholly within Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, a majority in interest of the owners of property or properties through whose land such road passes, or upon whose land it abuts, have given their consent and agreement to vacate and abandon the said road and have waived damages for the same;

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the supervisors that the said road is no longer necessary for the convenience of the public and that the vacating and abandoning of the said road is for the public interest, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same;

Section 1. The following described portion of road is hereby vacated and abandoned:

Beginning at the intersection of Township Road No. 455 and Township Road No. 454; thence in a Southwesterly direction through the farm land of Lewis and Edith Weaver a distance of approximately six tenths (0.6) of a mile to the lane leading to the buildings of the Marion L. Saylor, et ux. farm; and being the Northwesterly part of Township Road No. 455.

Section 2. That T. Dean Lower, Esq., the Township Solicitor, is authorized and directed to file a report on behalf of the Supervisors, including a certified copy of this Ordinance together with the names of the owners of property affected and a draft and survey of the road, in the Office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Blair County.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
