

ORDINANCE NO. 9

An Ordinance to lay out, take over and open a portion of road wholly within Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, a majority in interest of the owners of property or properties through whose land such road shall pass, or upon whose land it shall abut, have given their consent and agreement and have petitioned that the said road be laid out, taken over and opened;

WHEREAS, it is the judgment of the Supervisors that the said road is necessary for the convenience of the public and that the laying out, taking over and opening of the said road is for the public interest, now therefore;

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Supervisors of Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same:

Section 1. The following described portion of road is hereby laid out, taken over and opened:

Beginning on the easterly side of State Highway Route No. 866 in the village of Ganister between the points of intersection of the property of Marion D. and Evelyn J. Mingle and the property of Andy and Praska Martin with the said State Highway; thence in an easterly direction, at a width of thirty-three (33) feet, abutted on the northerly side by land of Marion D. & Evelyn Mingle, Elsie Kovensky, Mickey J. & Alice Sutlage, John & Barbara Shuta, and Frank Despot, and abutted on the southerly side by land of Andy & Praska Martin, Winco & Frances Kovacic, Nick & Mary Martin, John & Annie Youchison, Frank Despot, and the West Virginia Pulp & Paper Company, a distance of seven hundred fifty (750) feet, more or less, to the easterly boundary of land of Frank Despot on the northerly side of said road, said road to occupy the area now occupied by a 30-foot wide road and in addition to occupy an additional one and one-half (1½) feet from each of the properties abutting it on each side thereof to make the total width of thirty-three (33) feet. Said road to be hereafter known as "Edgewood Drive."

Section 2. That T. Dean Lower, Esquire, the Township Solicitor, is authorized and directed to file a report on behalf of the Supervisors, including a certified copy of this Ordinance together with the names of the property owners affected and a draft and survey of the road, in the Office of the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Blair County.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
