

ORDINANCE NO. 10

An Ordinance to take over, open, and maintain certain streets and alleys wholly within Robeson's Extension, Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania.

WHEREAS, a majority of owners of property or properties upon whose lands these streets and alleys abut, have petitioned the Board Supervisors of Catharine Township to take over, open, and maintain the same and;

AND WHEREAS, the Supervisors of said Township believe that the establishment and maintenance of these streets and alleys are for and in the interest of the public, now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board Supervisors of Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted:

Section 1. The following streets and alleys are hereby taken over and opened:

Beginning at North Plum Street at the intersection with Home Street; Home Street to Hill Alley, thence to fifty (50) feet beyond Chestnut Street;; Oak Alley from Home Street to Locust Street;; Home Street, beginning at the intersection with North High Street to the alley east of North High Street, thence on said alley to Locust Street;; Chestnut Street from North High Street east to an alley;; Walnut Street, from North High Street east to said alley;; Locust Street from North High Street east to said alley;; and Locust Street from North High Street to Oak Alley, the same being a part of the streets and alleys of the Extension to Williamsburg Borough, Blair County, Pennsylvania, and plotted by Isaac Krider for the late John B. Robeson and recorded in the office of the Registrar and Recorder of Blair County on April 20, 1925 and May 21, 1925.

Section 2. That Blair K. Hoover, secretary of said Catharine Township is hereby authorized and directed to file a report on behalf of said Supervisors, together with a certified copy of this ordinance and a draft of the streets and alleys to be taken over and opened with the Clerk of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Blair County, Pennsylvania.

Section 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances not consistent with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
