

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF CATHARINE TOWNSHIP REQUIRING THE COVERING WITH A TARPAULIN OR OTHER SUITABLE COVER OF ALL VEHICLES CARRYING GARBAGE, RUBBISH AND REFUSE AND PRESCRIBING FINES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township, County of Blair, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Any person, firm, corporation or other party using a vehicle for carrying garbage, rubbish and/or other refuse material within the limits of Catharine Township must have sufficient sides and tailboard and must keep the same covered with a tarpaulin or other suitable cover to prevent the contents from falling, blowing or otherwise being discharged from the vehicle.

SECTION 2. Any person, firm, corporation or other party violating the provisions of this ordinance, upon conviction thereof before a Justice of the Peace of the Township, shall be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars, and cost of prosecution, and, in default of payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment in the Blair County Jail for not more than ten (10) days.
