

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING PROPERTY TO BE CONNECTED WITH
ADJOINING OR ADJACENT SEWERS IN CATHERINE TOWNSHIP,
AUTHORIZING THE TOWNSHIP TO MAKE CONNECTIONS AT THE
EXPENSE OF THE PROPERTY OWNERS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Catherine Township Board of Supervisors,
assembled, and it is hereby Ordained and Enacted by the authority of the same
as follows:

SECTION 1. The word "person" as used in this ordinance, shall mean any
natural person, association, partnership, firm or corporation. The singular
shall include the plural and the masculine shall include the feminine and the
neuter.

The sanitary sewage shall be the normal water carried, household and toilet
waste from residences, business buildings, institutions, industries and commercial
establishments exclusive of storm water run off, surface water or ground water.

SECTION 2. Every property in Catherine Township adjoining and adjacent to
sanitary sewers shall connect with said sewer within a period of sixty (60) days
after notice to do so has been served upon him by the Supervisors, either by
personal service or by registered mail and upon failure to make such connections
the Supervisors or their agent may enter upon such property and construct such
connection. An itemized bill of the cost thereof shall be payable immediately
and in the event of neglect or refusal of the owner of such property to pay the
bill, the Township Supervisors may file a municipal lien as provided by the
Second Class Township Code.

SECTION 3. The grouping of buildings upon one house sewer shall not be
permitted except under special circumstances and for good sanitary reasons and
with the special permission of the Board of Supervisors.

SECTION 4. No privy vault, cess pool, septic tank or similar receptical
shall hereafter be maintained upon any premises after the connection with the
sanitary sewer as provided by this ordinance but the same shall be cleansed and
filled so as not to constitute a nuisance.

SECTION 5. Any person who shall violate or fail to conform to any of the
provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay
a fine of not more than twenty (\$20.00) dollars and costs of prosecution, and,
in default of payment of such fine and costs, to imprisonment for not more than
thirty (30) days. PROVIDED: each day's continuance of a violation, after notice
thereof by the Board of Supervisors shall constitute a separate offense.
