

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE
CONTROL AND REGULATION OF DOGS
WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF CATHARINE

BE IT ORDAINED AND ENACTED by the Board of Supervisors of Catharine Township in order to promote the health, cleanliness, comfort and safety of the citizens of Catharine Township and it is hereby ordained and enacted by the authority of the same as follows:

-1-

Any person owning or harboring a dog or dogs shall provide for a kennel or doghouse for the use of such dogs and locate the same no less than twenty (20) feet from adjoining properties and maintain it in a clean, dry and healthful condition, providing water and food for the animal. Failure to do so and allowing the animal to bark, causing annoyance and inconvenience to the people in the neighborhood, is hereby declared to be a nuisance.

-2-

The owner of any dog shall keep the animal upon his premises and shall not permit the animal to run at large.

-3-

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance will pay a fine not exceeding \$100.00 in costs or undergo imprisonment in the Blair County Jail for a period not exceeding five (5) days.
