

ORDINANCE NO. 53

An Ordinance amending Ordinance 35 and providing that it is unlawful and a violation of Catharine Township Ordinance No. 35 as amended to store, maintain, possess and/or accumulate junk or salvage for any purpose whatsoever without having a current Catharine Township license.

The Supervisors of Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the powers granted unto them by 53 P.S. §65101 et seq and the amendments thereto do hereby enact and ordain and it is hereby enacted and ordained as follows:

1.

Catharine Township Ordinance No. 35 is hereby amended by adding thereto the following: It is unlawful and a violation of this ordinance for any person within the Township of Catharine (as the word "person" is defined in this ordinance) to store, maintain, possess, and/or accumulate junk or salvage (as the words "junk or salvage" are defined in this ordinance) for any purpose whatsoever without having a current Catharine Township license as provided in this ordinance.

2.

In all other respects, the Supervisors of Catharine Township do hereby ratify and confirm the provisions of Ordinance 35 as supplemented and amended.

3.

All ordinances, resolutions or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

4.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be five days after the enactment and ordaining thereof.

5.

If any section, portion or provision of this ordinance is judicially held to be illegal, unconstitutional or unenforceable, such decision shall not effect the remainder hereof. It is hereby declared to be the intent and purpose of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Catharine that this ordinance would have been adopted if any such illegal unconstitutional or unenforceable provision had not been included herein.
