

CATHARINE TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE NO. 59

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RATE
OF REAL ESTATE TAX IN CATHARINE TOWNSHIP
AT 4.875 MILLS BEGINNING WITH THE YEAR 2010**

The Supervisors of the Township of Catharine in accordance with the powers granted unto them by 53 P.S. Section 6510 et seq and amendments thereto and the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, hereby enact the following:

1.

The rate of real estate tax in Catharine Township, Blair County, Pennsylvania, beginning with the year 2010 shall be 4.875 mills.

2.

This rate of real estate taxation of 4.875 mills shall continue without reenactment until changed.

3.

This change of real estate tax rate is intended to be revenue neutral. This change is caused by the change in assessment made by the County of Blair beginning with the year 2010.

4.

All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof, insofar as they are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

5.

All ordinances and resolutions or parts thereof, not inconsistent herewith, shall continue in full force and effect and are hereby ratified and confirmed.

6.

If any sentence, clause, section or part of this Ordinance is for any reason found to be unconstitutional, illegal or invalid, such unconstitutionality, illegality or invalidity shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections, or parts of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared as the intent of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Catharine that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such unconstitutional, illegal or invalid sentence, clause, or part thereof not been included therein.
